## Tips for Terrific Teams

**CONFLICT** - Don't avoid conflict! All great relationships require productive conflict in order to grow. Safe, polite, uncomplicated relationships allow no room to grow! Passionate debates are essential for any great team. Teams that engage in conflict have lively, interesting meetings and solve real problems quickly. Face conflict head on. This helps to put critical topics on the table for discussion and enables a team to call out sensitive issues and deal with them. Team leaders need to resist the desire to protect team members from harm and allow conflict resolution to occur naturally. By recognizing when people engaged in a conflict situation are getting uncomfortable with the level of discord a team member can interrupt the discussion to remind everyone that happiness is not the absence of conflict but the ability to handle it.
